ACTnow's Note

It is devastating to witness the increasing number of cases in the country. On 12 January 2021, Malaysian has reached its highest number of daily cases of 3309 cases. During the announcement of state of emergency on 12 January 2020, Prime Minister Muhyiddin Yassin has mentioned that currently, our frontliners are at a breaking point. Hence, Movement Control Order (MCO) 2.0, Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO), Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) and the State of Emergency are being strategically implemented to fight the infectious virus. Below is the list of states being placed under MCO 2.0, CMCO and RMCO from 13 Jan 2021 to 26 January 2021:

MCO	Penang, Selangor, Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya, Labuan, Malacca, Johor and Sabah.
CMCO	Pahang, Perak, Negeri Sembilan, Kedah, Terengganu, and Kelantan.
RMCO	Perlis and Sarawak.

ACTnow would like to advise and urge the public to commit to SOP to work together in breaking the chain of infections. Having a total of 581 clusters, 256 clusters are currently active whereas 325 have ended at the point of writing, definitely is not helping to add more to it. To do our part, ACTnow have taken the entire ACTnow team for a Covid test and we are glad to announce that we are all positively not detected. Hence, we would like to urge individuals or corporations to do the same as a precaution despite yet to have any detected cases. It is also important to sanitize your hands, wear reliable masks at all times and obey the distancing rules.

On a side note, some companies are still allowed to travel for work. Hence, #actnowpotholes challenge is still ongoing. Let's not be swayed by the fear of Covid and forget our duty as Malaysian to keep our communities safe. Recently, we have encountered multiple accidents related to potholes of which the victims died on the spot. In order to assist our Works Ministry to reach its Zero Pothole Policy, we seek for your help as the eyes of communities to take photos or videos of the potholes you may encounter, and insert #actnowpotholes as its title. From there, ACTnow will take it as priority to follow up on your behalf to relay it to the right authority.

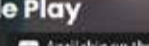
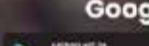
