



#### **ACTnow's Note**

#### Toddlers died in vehicles after being left a few hours due to forgetfulness

March 16,2021 - Happening in Sungai Petani, a kindergarten principal left the victim in the vehicle in the morning during arrival at the kindergarten until 12.15PM. The 3-year-old boy's parents had prior arrangement with the principal, where on every Tuesday and Wednesday, the latter would provide transport to and from the kindergarten.

However, on 16 March, the principal forgot about the toddler in the morning during arrival and accidentally locked the boy in the vehicle. At 12.15, when the principal wanted to take the boy home, she was notified by one of the teachers that the victim was absent for the class that day which brought her immediate realisation and rushed to the vehicle. Unfortunately, the victim was already unconscious. Despite trying performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), the victim was still motionless. After the ambulance arrived and brought the victim to Hospital Sultanah Bahiyah, he was pronounced dead by the doctor on duty.

Similar cases happened in multiple places from 2018 to 2020, where the victim aged between 9-month to 4-year-old. These cases happened due to the forgetfulness of their parents, grandparents, or even guardians. The death causes for the victims are mainly due to excessive heat after being carelessly left in the vehicle for a couple of hours.

ACTnow could not imagine being placed into the children's position being helplessly

trapped in the vehicle with striking hot sun and lack of oxygen, and eventually lead to slow but suffering deaths. Hence, ACTnow pleads parents or guardians to be mindful upon leaving the vehicle or set a reminder such as Waze's Child Reminder system to ensure that history does not repeat to your own children.




