






ACTnow's Note


This episode will be capturing the highlight from the interview with the Director of SWCORP Wilayah Persekutuan, Tuan Mohd Zahir bin Shari last week on the Hot Issue Talk Show. The interview started off where Tuan explained the vision of SWCORP which is towards a clean, beautiful and environmentally sustainable nation by 2020 and its mission to implement solid waste and public cleansing management policies and strategies in an integrated and effective manner by increasing public awareness and the usage of the latest technologies as well as the enforcement of the law to ensure a clean, healthy and sustainable environment.

Tuan has also expressed its intention towards a better Malaysia where the 3R Programmes (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle) have been implemented continuously from the stage of pre-schooling all the way to high school, as well as private and public offices and institutions. This is to ensure the habit is implemented from young as well as raising awareness to the adults to follow the same.

Another initiative mentioned was Separation At Source (SAS), which started from 1 September 2015, where it focuses on the importance of the responsibility of each individual to manage waste in the proper way. These will lead to a more efficient usage of landfill, reducing the cost of waste management nationwide, reducing pollutions, and many more benefits.

In September 2020, the fine for failure to separate wastes in each household has increased from RM50 to RM500. Authority will make an investigation by visiting your house to check if separation efforts are being made, if not a notice will be issued. Then further investigation will be made where authority will check your garbage disposal during garbage collection, if the amount of waste reaches 5 units of recyclable items, the household will be fined under the Act 672.

To wrap up the interview, Tuan encourages private sectors to help spread awareness and put in effort into implementing the 3R and SAS concept. It is through the effort of collaboration between different parties to enable cleanliness to be cultural in the nation.
