ACTnow has started a petition on 19 April 2021 in the effort to preserve Heritage Convent Bukit Nanas from moving out from their 122-year-old building due to the end of their lease term. This petition is to show that Malaysians will come together to preserve a heritage that our future generations deserve to see. ACTnow has since received over 35,000 supporters who signed the petition as of 22 April 2021. Visit change.org or ACTnow facebook to get to the petition and lend us a hand !

Apart from that, ACTnow has received a report (MY0001927) on a heavily leaking roof of KTMB Kajang Station. The rainwater is seen pouring in the middle of the waiting area of the station, causing slippery roads and potential fatality. Upon communication with KTMB's management team, we have received a response from En Jamil, the technician of the said location, stating that it requires 3 months for repairment. This is unacceptable because many accidents may happen prior to the fixing. Many elderly as well as children could be using the train services in this period, with the constant slippery floor, they may fall and injure themselves, it is even more dangerous considering that a high-speed train is constantly operating. This issue is deeply concerning to the public users of the services.

ACTnow has since issued an Open Letter sent to the CEO of KTMB, YBrs. Encik Mohd. Rani Hisham bin Samsudin stated the concerned issue and unacceptable lengthy fixing period as well as ACTnow's extreme concern for the people taking the public transport on a daily basis.

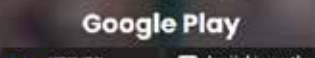
