In the recent month, a Form 5 student Ain Husniza Saiful Nizam has been the talk of the town. Ain received lewd and rape jokes from her male teacher during a physical and health education class causing her to be afraid to attend school thereon. She brought it to the famous social media platform, Tiktok to expose her teacher for making such inappropriate jokes including telling the boys in class, if they were to commit rape, they should target those above 18. This video prompted widespread outrage on social media. During this time of being absent from school, Ain had received a warning letter stating that she could be expelled if she continues being absent or fails to provide a valid reason, however, there were no actions taken on the teacher and her male classmates. Her father, Saiful Nizam expressed utter disappointment over the issue and is seeking an explanation from the school.

In a series of comments, the principal Sarimah Mohamed Nor called Ain "Hyprocite" as well as "Satan's spawn wearing headscarves" and told Ain's parents to "educate her with manners". The public, including politicians, celebrities, and athletes have since come together to support Ain and her movement #MakeSchoolASaferPlace.

Apart from that, some schools, especially boarding schools were found to have practiced period spot checks which are a complete violation of a person's privacy. This has shocked some politicians and the public when the news came out. Dewan Rakyat deputy speaker expressed that this was pure harassment, as well as moral and religious policing that oversteps the basic human right to dignity. According to current students as well as those who left the school 20 years ago, they had to go through period spot checks to physically prove that they are on their period, which includes showing their blood-soaked sanitary pads, doing swabs on their genital with either cotton buds, tissues or their fingers, or having school prefect pat them down at the groin to check if they are wearing sanitary pad.

Majlis Amanah Rakyat (MARA) have stepped forward to cooperate with authorities to put a stop to this disgusting practice. MARA chairman, Datuk Azizah Mohd Dun pledged to take stern actions to ensure conducive, safe and independent educational environment, free from sexual harassment and the exploitation of women and children.

ACTnow finds sexual harassment in Malaysian schools should be stopped immediately. Hence, ACTnow has started a petition to urge the government to take prompt and stern actions against these harassments. This is not how our Malaysian education systems should be established.
